The Towns of Andover, Bolton, Columbia and Coventry are working toward a cooperative approach to economic development along the Route 6 Hop River Corridor via the Route 6 Regional Economic Development Council. The Corridor includes an 11-mile stretch of Route 6 between Notch Road in Bolton and Route 66 in Columbia and a 2-mile segment of Route 66 between Route 6 and the Willimantic River.

A Planning Project is currently underway to explore, define, and consider the economic development potential for the Route 6 Hop River Corridor. The final recommendations from this study will be presented including utility improvements, suggested land use regulations, and a strategy for economic development.

A companion Transportation Study is just starting up to review safety and access management along the Corridor and evaluate existing and future land use as they relate to the supporting transportation system. An introduction to this study will be provided.
